Nadia studied piano, clarinet and harpsichord at the Royal Academy of Music, winning the Manns Memorial Prize. An experienced performer of concertos, lieder and chamber music, she also has wide experience of teaching. Former Head of Keyboard and Chamber Music at James Allens Girls School for 15 years, she still teaches there, at the junior departments of the Royal College of Music, at Trinity College of Music and has private teaching. Nadia is a firm believer in the value of ensemble playing for all ages and standards, running ensemble workshops in the UK and all over the world. She has become a leading authority on the numerous publications for all genres of ensemble that include one or more pianos, is the founder of 'Piano 40' (a piano quartet of 8 hands at 2 pianos) and her publication 'Piano Neednt Be Lonely', a Guide to over 600 pieces of Chamber Music and Multipiano Repertoire and is now in its third edition. She is a Festival Adjudicator and former Examiner for the Associated Board.
