

Performers who are also singers or instrumentalists and were aged 15 years or under on 1st September 2025 may also wish to enter the Sproule Prize & Trophy for Speech, Drama and Music. Please see the Special Classes section for more details.

Unless otherwise stated, classes are competitive and places will be awarded. Times, dates and venues for all classes are subject to confirmation once all entries have been received. The committee reserve the right to combine and/or separate classes by age or size of group, dependent upon the number of entries received.

Solo performers may enter only one class appropriate for their age on 1st September 2025 and the open class in each of the categories above. Groups of more than one performer (that are made up of exactly the same performers) may enter only one class appropriate for the age of the oldest performer in the group on 1st September 2025 and the open class in each section. However, individuals may perform as part of more than one group as long as they adhere to the age limits. A different piece must be performed for each entry.

Full details of the piece(s) to be performed do not have to be included at the time of entry (simply put TBC) but please ensure entries are updated with the name and author of the work by 16th January 2026 at the latest. Performers must provide a written copy of their extract for the adjudicator (except for improvisation and sightreading classes).

Please also see essential information for entrants at the end of the drama syllabus.

ACTING

Own choice of excerpt from any published play to be performed from memory. Performers must provide a written copy of their scene or extract for the adjudicator. Performers must provide a brief introduction at the beginning of their performance. This is included in the time limit.

Essential information for all drama entrants

Performers are reminded that due to Performing Rights restrictions, neither full costume/makeup nor scenery may be used but movement and basic props are permitted. The following items are acceptable: scarves/shawls, headwear, gloves, fans and other hand-held small items. Mobile phones, kindles, iPads, e-readers and laptops are not permitted unless they are required for the use of music and/or sound effects or as a hand prop.

The Festival has an agreement with the Authors' Licensing and Collecting Society. This means that entrants do not have to seek copyright permission for any poetry, prose or SOLO dramatic item. Duologues and group dramatic activity are NOT covered by this agreement and copyright for these items should be sought by entrants.

Unacceptable Language Thresholds: Some works performed explore adult themes and/or contain strong language. However, care should be taken when choosing or devising contemporary pieces. We ask that you present your work in a manner that respects the 'family' orientated nature of WCAF and avoids the unnecessary exposure of younger children to inappropriate themes and language.

WCAF aims to celebrate the best and highest forms of literature and language, and therefore reserves the right to refuse entries that are made up of continuously bad language and/or gratuitous expletives. Therefore, all entrants to the speech, drama and musical theatre sections are now asked to confirm whether their performance contains adult language or content upon entry. If you indicate you have potentially contentious language or themes, we will be in contact to discuss. This does not necessarily mean you will not be able to perform the piece - we just want to make sure that we make appropriate arrangements for you to be able to perform to your best.
