90-94 (or Outstanding) - An impressive performance technically and artistically, displaying spontaneity & clear individuality

85-89 (or Honours) - An excellent performance, demonstrating fluent technical and artistic skills with emerging individuality

80-84 (or Commended) - A convincing performance technically & artistically, with increasing stylistic & communication skills

75-79 (or Merit) - A competent performance, showing some artistic awareness and/or technical ability

70-74 (or Progressing) - A performance showing development of technique and/or communication and commitment

65-69 (or Developing) - A performance demonstrating an awareness of technical skills, requiring more consistency & artistry
